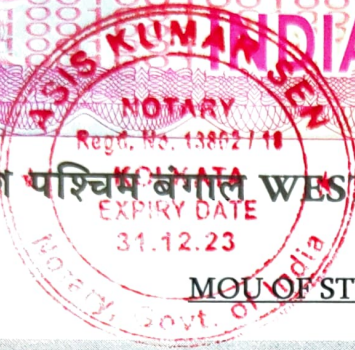

- 2.3. All such acts and programmes that are connected to and/or ancillary to purposes (2.1) and (2.2) above.

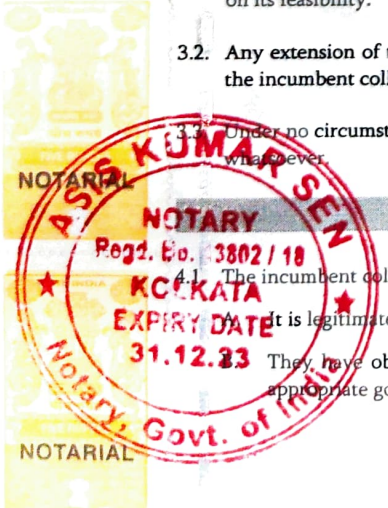
**3. TENURE OF THE UNDERSTANDING**



**6. TERMINATION**



- 6.1. This understanding can only be terminated in writing with the mutual consent of both the incumbent colleges.

- 7.1. In case of any dispute concerning this understanding, the same shall be tried to be resolved in Mediation through the respective representatives of this understanding or any person nominated by them, in their joint mediation.
- 7.2. All disputes and differences arising out of this understanding, if not settled in Mediation as aforesaid in terms of sub-clause (7.1) of this clause, shall be resolved in Arbitration before a sole Arbitrator to be jointly nominated by the parties herein to that effect upon mutual discussion and in terms of the provisions of THE ARBITRATION AND CONCILIATION ACT, 1996 (As Amended till Date). The proceedings before the Arbitrator shall be in English.
- 7.3. The sole Arbitrator to be nominated by the parties under this agreement shall be an Indian national and a qualified working/retired professor/assistant professor of Software Development (SD) or Department of Banking, Financial Services and Insurance (BFSI) of any college (other than the incumbent colleges) affiliated to any state/national university having his place of residence in the city of Kolkata. Persons having previous experience of adjudication of disputes arising under similar agreements shall be given preference while selecting an Arbitrator.
